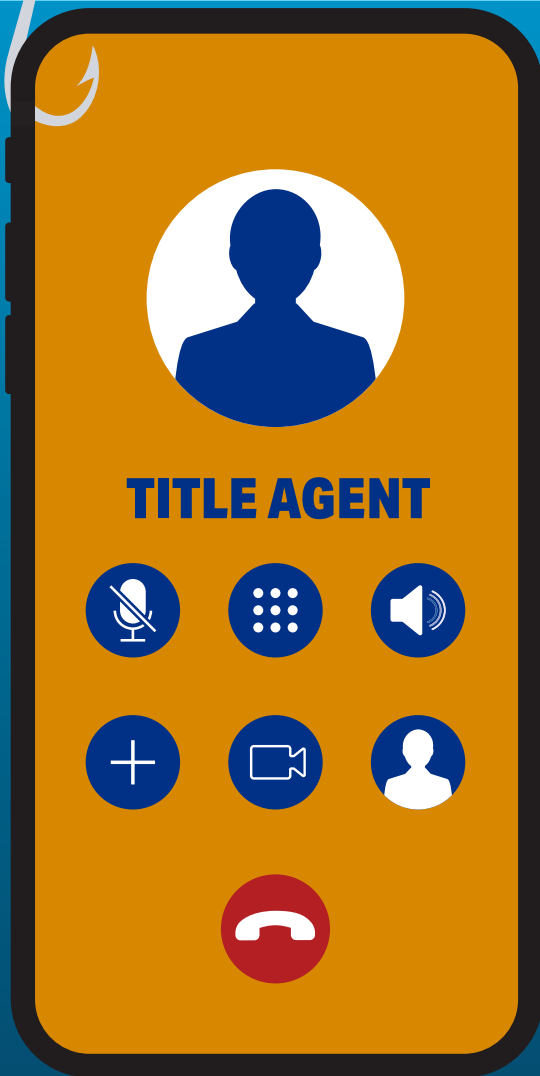


DON'T GET HOOKED!

How to Recognize and Avoid Phishing Attacks

"In order to close your transaction on time, there has been a change in the wire instructions. Can you please provide me with your bank account information?"

Don't trust your Caller ID!

Cybercriminals can manipulate the Caller ID details that appear on your phone. If a caller claims to be from your Title Agent's office and seeks personal information, tell the caller you are going to hang up to verify the information. Then, call a trusted phone number you have on file.

Think before you click, send or speak.

- Is the message or call expected?
- Can I verify the sender or caller?
- Does the request(s) make sense?
